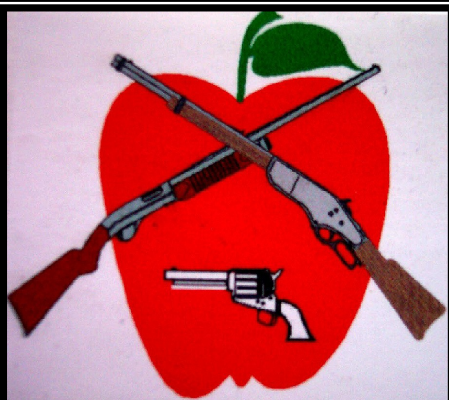

NOTICE OF BY-LAW CHANGE— CONFLICT OF INTEREST

ARTICLE THREE: OFFICERS AND TRUSTEES (AND INDEMNIFICATION)...

Section 4 Officers or Board Members with voting rights and/or signature authority in the name of the Gun Club that take part in the decision-making process that awards contracts to other parties seeking to do business with NCWGC --- or who make recommendations with respect to the award of a contract for NCWGC --- shall not own any interest in, have any personal agreement with third parties or receive any personal loss or gain resulting from the terms and conditions of any said contract.

Prior to discussion, vote, or signature, on said contract or agreement, any Officer or Board Member that is not able to fulfill the obligations outlined above shall disclose this fact to the board of directors and formally abstain in any discussion or vote in the awarding of said contract or bid.

Any officer or Board Member in signature or vote that is found to be non-compliant with this section shall cause said contract or agreement will be considered to have no legal standing thus null and void.
